Investing in opportunities for development for teaching assistants (TAs) is an important responsibility of all schools. Our *Teaching Assistant Development Programme* (TADP) provides TAs with a flexible and personalised CPD programme which can help you make the most of your TAs as well as giving them a greater say in their own development.

How it works


Each TA completes a simple online self-evaluation which analyses their professional development needs.

Give teaching TAs a greater say in their own development

Based on their responses, the system builds an individually tailored programme of courses from from the *CPD Library*, each course targeting an area the TA will improve upon. Every time a TA completes a course, they will be awarded a digital badge to show evidence of achievement.

TAs can access the courses online and offline on mobile phones and tablets, or via the web. Conveniently, the courses can be built into existing staff training provision.





Progress reports

The school receives a report summarising all the TAs' responses, helping leaders to make decisions about deployment. Those managing the TADP also receive reports for each TA detailing the courses they are working on and how they are progressing.
