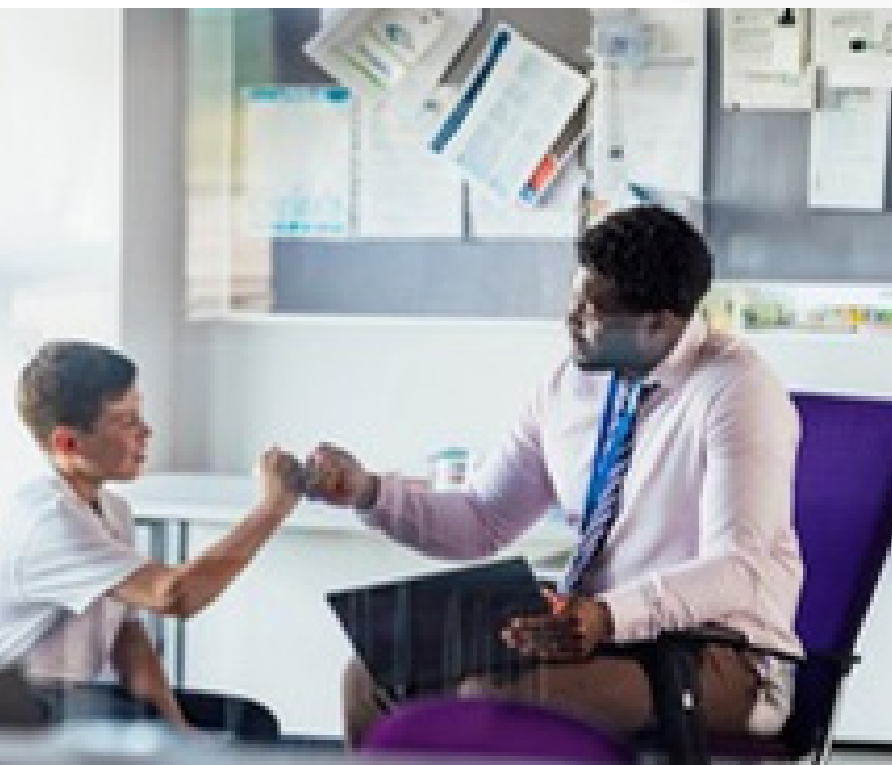

About the Programme

A Pastoral Support Practitioner, at times known as an Early Intervention Specialist, in a school setting identifies and supports children of all ages with developmental delays, disabilities, or behavioral challenges. They implement tailored strategies, such as Individualised Education Plans (IEPs) or small-group interventions, to improve learning outcomes, boost social-emotional skills, and prevent long-term difficulties.

Who is this programme for?

This programme is for school staff working directly with pupils and families to address barriers to learning attendance and engagement. As a Pastoral Support Practitioner, you will provide a person-centred, early intervention approach and service supporting pupils and parents.

Employer Benefits

The Level 4 Pastoral Support Practitioner apprenticeship helps schools strengthen internal capacity to respond to complex needs and demonstrate inclusive practice aligned with Ofsted and sector priorities.

These include:

- Identifying needs early (Quality of Education, Behaviour and Attitudes)
- Supporting early identification of barriers to learning, attendance and wellbeing, which underpins pupils' ability to access the curriculum
- Improving attendance and behaviour (Behaviour and Attitudes)
- Putting consistent, effective support in place to improve attendance, engagement and conduct

This funded training programme helps schools demonstrate the behaviours Ofsted looks for within their main judgment areas: identifying needs early, taking effective action and creating an environment where pupils feel supported, included and able to thrive.

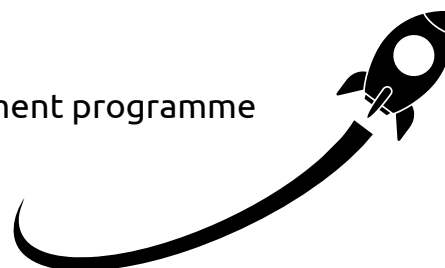

What will you learn

In this Level 4 Pastoral Support Practitioner programme you will expand your knowledge in areas such as identifying early warning signs in attendance, behaviour and wellbeing, communicating effectively with parents and carers and carrying out risk assessments and safeguarding referrals.

These sessions support learners to apply their knowledge in real-world contexts and develop skills through interactive activities.

Off the job training

Off-the-job hours are a vital part of this apprenticeship. Training is directly relevant to the programme and can take many forms, including:

- Individual study time for reflection and growth

- Group learning opportunities (like inset days)
- Shadowing experienced colleagues
- Mentoring from line managers
- 1:1 performance reviews and feedback
- Attending meetings and briefings
- Learning new policies

- Professional development
- Online courses
- Enrichment activities
- Research and learning
- Collaborative planning/resource preparation

Apprenticeship assessment

The (end-point) assessment is **an independent assessment that takes place at the end of the apprenticeship training**. This is to test that the apprentice is competent in their occupation. All apprentices must complete this assessment. There are a variety of assessment methods to test apprentices' competency.

Gateway

Gateway takes place before the apprenticeship assessment. LMP Education will work with the employer to **review their apprentice's knowledge, skills and behaviours**. This period of time is used to see if the apprentice has met the requirements of the apprenticeship set out in the apprenticeship standard, and they are ready to take the assessment.

Functional Skills

LMP Education provides functional skills support to all our learners. While functional skills are no longer a requirement for learners who are 19+, LMP still offers functional skills training for those who choose to take the qualification.
